Our Next General Meeting: Will be held on Tuesday, November 7th in the church on Berry Hill and Grand. Social time 6:30 pm, meeting will be called to order at 7:00 pm. Last Meeting: We had a Pasco County code enforcement officer in to have a Q&A session with us. Their new name is Code Compliance. A few tidbits; 1) They work with homeowners reasonably - providing time to fix issues. The idea is to fix not fine. If things are not fixed it would eventually result in a citation and court appearance. 2) Garbage Cans must be county approved styles and have appropriate lids. Our deed restrictions require them to be hidden from view and not put out before 5pm. 3) Phone number 727-847-2411 - you get a REAL person who can connect you with correct departments.

December Meeting: Our December meeting will be on December 5th. We will be holding a brief meeting where new Officers and Directors will be elected. Island Committee: Regarding the lake breach, a resident recently noticed 2 power boats attempting to push thru the downed foliage, trying to reach the lake. They were politely turned away. The fate of repairing the breach or allowing it to remain, and likely increase in size, still sits with the Corps of Engineers. The Anclote River is tidal waterway. That means the river is affected by the ocean's tide, making the water in our area brackish (salty). Those who live along the Anclote have seen the river rise from storm water runoff as well as the impact hurricanes can have on the water level. The berm along the lake had been a barrier against the rising flood water levels in the Anclote.

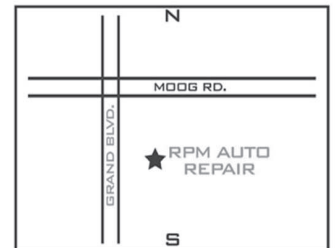
